THE CLEAN NEIGHBOURHOODS AND ENVIRONMENT ACT 2005

THE DOG CONTROL ORDERS (PRESCRIBED OFFENCES AND PENALTIES, ETC) REGULATIONS 2006

Notice is hereby given of the intention of the Council of the Borough and County of the Town of Poole to introduce orders pursuant to its powers under the Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005.

Order One – The Dogs Exclusion (Hamworthy Park Playground) Order 2007

This Order will prohibit people from taking dogs into the playground at Hamworthy Park.

There will be exceptions for people who are blind, deaf or have a disability and are using trained assistance dogs.

Order Two – The Dogs Exclusion (Beaches between Western End Promenade Sandbanks and Branksome Chine Beach Office) Order 2007

This Order will prohibit people from taking dogs onto the beaches between Western End Promenade Sandbanks and Branksome Chine Beach Office between 1 May and 30 September.

There will be exceptions for people who are blind, deaf or have a disability and are using trained assistance dogs.

Order Three – The Dogs Exclusion (Hamworthy Beach from the Western End to beach hut number 97) Order 2007

This Order will prohibit people from taking dogs onto Hamworthy Beach from the Western End to beach hut number 97 between 1 May and 30 September.

There will be exceptions for people who are blind, deaf or have a disability and are using trained assistance dogs.

Order Four – The Dogs on Leads (Hamworthy Park) Order 2007

This Order will require people in charge of a dog within Hamworthy Park to keep it on a lead.

Order Five – The Dogs on Leads (The Promenade between Western End Promenade Sandbanks and the border with Bournemouth) Order 2007

This Order will require people in charge of a dog on the beach promenade between Western End Promenade Sandbanks and the border with Bournemouth to keep it on a lead between 1 May and 30 September.

Fixed Penalty Notices

The Borough of Poole intends to issue fixed penalty notices to enforce the proposed dog control orders above, as prescribed by Section 59 Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005. The payment would be £75 within fourteen days or £50 if paid within seven days.

Failure to pay the fixed penalty notices may result in prosecution.

Consultation

Maps showing the areas affected by these Orders will be available for inspection free of charge at Environmental and Consumer Protection Services, Unit 1 Newfields Business Park, Stinsford Road, Poole, BH17 0NF between the hours of 8.30am and 5.15pm Monday to Thursday and 8.30am and 4.45pm on Fridays during the consultation period.
